Financial Assistance

Apply now for 2025-26 financial assistance. If you will attend (or think you might attend) Lakeside Lutheran High School, Luther Preparatory School, Martin Luther College or Wisconsin Lutheran Seminary during the 2025-26 school year, please apply by March 29, 2025 to receive financial assistance from the St. Mark's Scholarship Program. (If you received a scholarship during 2024-25, you must reapply for 2025-26.) Your congregation exists, in part, to provide you with a Christian education that will equip you to be a disciple for Jesus in the world. Every St. Mark's members who attend these schools are eligible to receive a scholarship, but we need families to complete a simple application form. If you will attend St. Mark's elementary school during 2025-26, financial aid will be available at the time of school registration in August 2025.

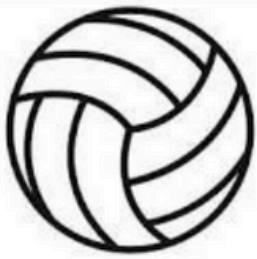
