Wednesday- SUPPLY them with thanks!



Enrollment Information for Parents of Parochial/Non WUSD Students Grades 4K-8

- The WUSD will use Online Scheduling through <u>Skyward Family Access</u> for students in grades 4K-8.
- Registration for classes will begin Monday, April 7 at 4:00 pm and close Friday, May 2, 2025. (Register for classes based on your child's current grade this school year.)
- Summer School is free.
- ◆ All parochial students and any students not attending a WUSD school will need to fill out the enrollment form by March 28, 2025 Please note *Students will not be able to schedule classes without filling out the enrollment form to be activated in Skyward. You must fill out this form even if you attended last year. We need to activate your student. Please go to WUSD website https://www.watertown.k12.wi.us under School-WUSD Summer School to fill out the form

Skyward login and password will be the same for students who have previously attended summer school. If you do not remember your Skyward login information, please contact Cheryl Hollatz hollatzc@mywusd.org

New student information will be e-mailed to the parent/guardian. **The enrollment** form must be completed and the student entered into Skyward prior to emailing for login and password information.
